

## Spanish 2 Spring Study Guide – 2015

Your final will consist of 3 parts: listening/reading/grammar, speaking, and writing. This final is cumulative; you must know all grammar and vocab from this semester. See below for the weighting of each part.

### Listening/Reading/Grammar- (30%)

- Given on our regular exam day
- Will have 2 readings: concentrate on the imperfect, preterit, childhood vocabulary, hace + time
- Will have 2 listenings: concentrate on childhood vocabulary, imperfect, tú commands
- Will have a short (20-25 question) multiple choice section. What you must know includes, but is not limited to, present/imperfect/preterit verbs, commands, indirect and direct object pronouns, present progressive, demonstrative adjectives, childhood, family gathering, clothing and town/errands vocabulary.
- You may use one hand written piece of paper as an aid. You can write on the front and back and fill it with any information you think you will need. If it is typed, I won't let you use it.

### Speaking- (35%)

### Writing- (35%)

- Due on May 19/20
- You will answer 3 questions in about 30 words each.
- You will have 5 questions to choose from.
- Topics include: family, childhood, shopping, getting ready for an event, free time, reflexive verbs, preterit/imperfect
