

## Spanish 3, Spring Final 2015

Your final will consist of 3 parts: listening/reading/grammar, speaking, and writing. This final is cumulative; you must know all grammar and vocab from this semester. See below for the weighting of each part.

### Listening and reading/grammar: 30%

- Given on our regular exam day
- Will have 2 listening and 2 reading activities, followed by some multiple choice grammar questions.
- Will concentrate on the Friendship unit and the Jobs and Volunteering unit.
- Know subjunctive, preterit and imperfect
- You may use one hand written piece of paper as an aid. You can write on the front and back and fill it with any information you think you will need. If it is typed, I won't let you use it.

### Speaking: 35%

- Due Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup>
- Work days will be May 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>.
- You and a partner will prepare a mock interview. You will perform this interview for me on May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- During the interview you must show that you can-
  - Use the subjunctive
  - Use the preterit and imperfect
  - Use the future tense

### Writing: 35%

- Due May 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Work days will be May 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>/15<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>.
- You will answer one question in 150 Spanish words about what you will do in the future. Make sure you know how to use the future tense.
- You will also answer one more question in 50 Spanish words. You will have a choice of 4 questions to choose from. Topics are: friendships, travel, subjunctive, preterit/imperfect.
- You may use one hand written piece of paper as an aid. You can write on the front and back and fill it with any information you think you will need. If it is typed, I won't let you use it.
